Finishing the Pendant

1. Cut a 6-inch piece of beading thread. 2. Fold the thread in half and create a loop at the top of the pendant. 3. Attach the clasp and jump ring to the loop.

Tips and Tricks

* Use high-quality seed beads and beading thread for durability. * Pay attention to the tension of your thread to avoid loose or tight stitches. * If you make a mistake, simply loosen the thread and remove the beads until you reach the error. * Experiment with different bead colors and patterns to create unique pendants.
