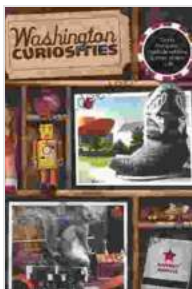

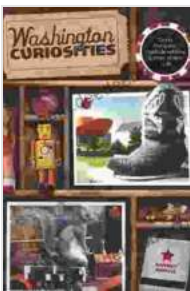
Discover the Offbeat
