

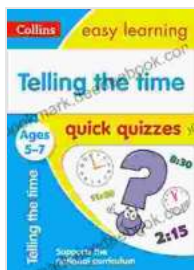
Telling the Time: Quick Quizzes for Ages 5 and Up

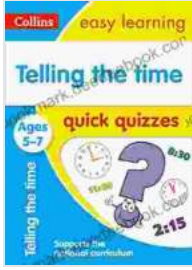
